DairyTrace offers multiple ways for producers outside of Quebec to report traceability events. Some reporting methods require manual entry or third party assistance while others are reported automatically. Choose the option(s) that work best for you. When you register an animal through your Breed Association, or its identification number changes and needs to be cross referenced, Holstein Canada will automatically transfer the associated traceability event(s) to DairyTrace on your behalf. Just remember, the birth must be registered before 45 days to comply with proAction reporting requirements or before the animal leaves the farm of origin, whichever occurs first. Traceability reporting through Holstein Canada is a two-step

process. When traceability events are reported via Holstein Canada field staff, customer services, or Webservices, the information is transferred to DairyTrace Customer Services for entry.

Submission of electronic registration applications (ERA) to Breed Associations automatically creates a tag activation event for registered animals. In Atlantic provinces, when the technician visits your farm, they can submit traceability events on your behalf. Enter your herd information all in one place and seamlessly upload your traceability events to DairyTrace.
